To whom it may concern,

I am President of Haltom City Rifle and Pistol Club (HCRPC), a 770 member shooting club located at 2100 Minnis Dr, Haltom City TX 76117. We share a driveway and apparently, some land usage, with the Progressive Waste Solutions of TX facility (CN600321871) known as the Minnis Drive Transfer Station.

The club has in the past had to remind Progressive of its property boundaries and has asked that transport vehicles not be left in our parking lot. We wish to have it stated now, that while we do not seek to impede the utilization of the transfer station, we do wish to maintain safe, free and unfettered access to our parking lot and range facility.

A review of our property survey (attached) shows much of the graveled area to the north of our range, which is often used by trucks to transfer loads prior to dumping in the transfer facility, is HCRPC property. In addition to previous trailer storage events. We asked Progressive to not park in the club parking lot and thus far, they have complied 100%.

We just want to make the commission aware of the possible hazards of mixing pedestrian, personal vehicle and high volume large hauler traffic in this confined area. It can be done, safely, but certain housekeeping requirements must be met to maintain safety.
